AN ACT

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P. L. 1206), entitled “An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating thereto,” permitting townships to make appropriations to industrial development agencies.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

The First Class Township Code.

Section 1. Section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 (P. L. 1206), known as “The First Class Township Code,” reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P. L. 1955), is amended by adding, at the end thereof, a new clause to read:

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners. The board shall have power:

LX. Appropriations for Industrial Promotions.—To make appropriations to an industrial development agency.
