AN ACT

SB 600

Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," changing a route in Plains Township, Luzerne County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following route established by the act of June 22, 1931 (P. L. 594), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," added August 27, 1963 (P. L. 1306), is amended to read:

Luzerne County

Route 40180. Beginning at the intersection of Legislative Route [40046] 5 and [Township Road 300 (Courtright Avenue)] *Courtright Street East*, thence in a *generally* southeasterly direction over [Township Road 300] *Courtright Street East* to its intersection with Legislative Route 40038, a distance of approximately [0.12] *0.20* mile, in Plains Township, Luzerne County.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
