Repealing the act of June 12, 1893 (P. L. 453), entitled "An act providing a system whereby cities may pave streets and alleys, pay the cost thereof by the issue of bonds and collect the same from the property benefited, in instalments," in so far as it applies to cities of the first class.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of June 12, 1893 (P. L. 453), entitled "An act providing a system whereby cities may pave streets and alleys, pay the cost thereof by the issue of bonds and collect the same from the property benefited, in instalments," is repealed in so far as it applies to cities of the first class.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
