HB 1664

Amending the act of April 28, 1961 (P.L.135), entitled "An act authorizing the licensing of public weighmasters; defining their powers and duties; providing for the collection and disposition of license fees and imposing penalties for violations," reducing certain age requirements.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 4, act of April 28, 1961 (P.L.135), known as the "Public Weighmaster's Act," is amended to read:

Section 4. A citizen of the United States, who is a resident of the Commonwealth, not less than [twenty-one] *eighteen* years of age, of good moral character, and who has the ability to weigh accurately and to make correct weight certificates, and who has received from the director a license as a licensed public weighmaster, shall be styled and authorized to act as a licensed public weighmaster.
