HB 1711

Authorizing persons eighteen years of age and older to enter into contracts.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Any person eighteen years of age and older shall have the right to enter into binding and legally enforceable contracts and the defense of minority shall not be available to such persons.
