Repealing the act of March 23, 1868 (P.L.424), entitled "An act to secure farmers against losses caused by railroads in Erie county," and its supplement of April 13, 1868 (P.L.1022), entitled "A supplement to an act, entitled 'An act to secure farmers against losses caused by railroads in Erie county,' approved on the twenty-third day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, exempting certain lands from its operations, and to provide for cases where farmers may be harmed by said railroad companies."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of March 23, 1868 (P.L.424), entitled "An act to secure farmers against losses caused by railroads in Erie county," and its supplement of April 13, 1868 (P.L.1022), entitled "A supplement to an act, entitled 'An act to secure farmers against losses caused by railroads in Erie county,' approved on the twenty-third day of March, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, exempting certain lands from its operations, and to provide for cases where farmers may be harmed by said railroad companies," are repealed absolutely.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
