Designating the Pennsylvania Lumber Museum at Denton Hill, Potter County, Pennsylvania, as The James S. Berger Lumber Museum.

Section 1. The Pennsylvania Lumber Museum at Denton Hill, Potter County, Pennsylvania, is hereby designated and shall hereinafter be known as The James S. Berger Lumber Museum.
