SB 548

Designating a certain bridge crossing the Allegheny River as the George D. Stuart Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The bridge carrying Route A-9801 over the Allegheny River between Tarentum in Allegheny County and New Kensington in Westmoreland County is hereby officially designated and shall be known as the "George D. Stuart Bridge."

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
