Amending the act of November 18, 1968 (P.L.1052, No.322), entitled "An act providing for the certification of sewage treatment plant and waterworks operators; creating the State Board for Certification of Sewage Treatment Plant and Waterworks Operators and prescribing its powers and duties; conferring powers and duties upon the Department of Health; and providing penalties," clarifying the application of the act to professional engineers.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 7, act of November 18, 1968 (P.L.1052, No.322), known as the "Sewage Treatment Plant and Waterworks Operators' Certification Act," is amended to read:

Section 7. Professional Engineers.—(a) Anyone registered under the "Professional Engineers Registration Law," approved May 23, 1945 (P.L.913), who has been examined in civil or sanitary engineering or otherwise proves he is proficient shall be granted a certificate upon application to the board.

(b) Subsection (a) of this section or any other provision of this act shall not be construed to require certification and registration for operation of any class of treatment plant or distribution system by a professional engineer registered under the "Professional Engineers Registration Law" who is competent to perform professional civil or sanitary engineering services.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
