Authorizing the Department of State to reserve from use the name "Pennsylvania Military College."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The former Pennsylvania Military College had an outstanding history. No entity, organization or institution formed or coming into existence hereafter should be able to adopt Pennsylvania Military College as its name.

Section 2. The Department of State is directed to reserve from use by any entity, organization or institution formed or coming into existence hereafter the name Pennsylvania Military College.
