SB 983

Amending the act of May 18, 1945 (P.L.809, No.323), entitled "An act removing certain roads or sections of road from the State highway system; and providing for their future maintenance and construction," removing a route in Armstrong County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of May 18, 1945 (P.L.809, No.323), entitled "An act removing certain roads or sections of road from the State highway system; and providing for their future maintenance and construction," amended October 11, 1951 (P.L.1657, No.440), is amended by removing the following route:

Section 1. The following described roads, which were added to the State highway system under the provisions of the act, approved the twenty-seventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws 409), entitled "An act authorizing the Secretary of Highways to join two or more State highway routes, by the construction of connecting roads, under certain conditions, and providing for the payment of damages for land taken in the construction of such connecting roads," or under the provisions of section 217 of the act, approved the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred forty-five (Pamphlet Laws 1242), known as the "State Highway Law," and which have been numbered by the Secretary of Highways, as indicated, are hereby removed from the said system:

ARMSTRONG COUNTY

Route 03138 Spur E. Beginning at the westerly terminus of Route 03138 about 2.0 miles west of Kittanning Borough; thence in a northerly direction through East Franklin Township to Route 71, in Armstrong County, a distance of about 0.06 of a mile.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
