AN ACT

HB 1733

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," authorizing taxation for the purpose of appropriating funds to support ambulance and rescue squads.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1302, act of February 1, 1966 (P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 1302. Tax Levy.—The council of the borough shall have power, by ordinance, to levy and collect annually, a tax, not exceeding thirty mills for general borough purposes and in addition thereto any of the following taxes:

* * *

(9) For the purpose of supporting ambulance and rescue squads serving the borough, not to exceed one-half mill.
