SB 1272

Providing for adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the Fish Fund, Boating Fund, and the Game Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Itemization and Adoption of Projects.—The 1973-74 Capital Budget projects in the category of public improvement projects, to be financed from current revenues of the Fish Fund, Boating Fund or the Game Fund pursuant to Executive Authorizations and to be constructed and/or acquired by the Pennsylvania Fish Commission or the Pennsylvania Game Commission are hereby itemized together with their respective estimated cost, as follows:

I. Pennsylvania Fish Commission

(a) Fish Fund

- (1) Acquisition of Shugert Springs - Pleasant Gap Hatchery, Centre County \$ 25,000
- (2) Access Area Development - Struble Lake, Chester County 25,000
- (3) Land Acquisition - Girard Township, Erie County 35,000
- (4) Stream Improvement - Big Spring Creek, Cumberland County 40,000

(b) Boating Fund

- (1) Land Acquisition - East Brady Access, Allegheny River, Armstrong County 30,300
- (2) Access Area Development, Neshaminy State Park, Bucks County 90,000
- (3) Land Acquisition and Access Area Development, Goldsboro, York County 73,000

II. Pennsylvania Game Commission

(a) Game Fund

- (1) Acquisition of State Game Lands 1,000,000

Section 2. Effective Date.—This act shall take effect immediately.
