HB 176

Authorizing the Governor to allocate funds necessary to provide for the repair or replacement of certain personal property damaged or destroyed in the great storms and floods of September, 1971 and June, 1972.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The Governor is hereby authorized to allocate from funds appropriated under the act of July 7, 1972 (Act No. 18-A), as much money as may be necessary to provide for the repair or replacement of motor vehicles commandeered or appropriated by a governmental or quasi-governmental agency which certifies the motor vehicles were commandeered or appropriated for flood emergency operations in the great storms and floods of September, 1971 and June, 1972 and for the repair or replacement of equipment and property losses of the Civil Air Patrol and of watercraft provided or used by private citizens for flood emergency operations which motor vehicles, equipment, property and watercraft were damaged, destroyed or lost in the great storms and floods of September, 1971 and June, 1972: Provided, however, That no payment shall be made for any loss which has been compensated for from any other source.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
