Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," changing routes in Washington County and providing for future maintenance and construction of deleted portions by such county.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The following routes in Washington County established by the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," are amended to read:

Washington County

Route 62032. Beginning at [road 1.25 miles southeast of B & O R. R. Station at Gamble; intersection of L. R. 62052, thence easterly through North Strabane and Nottingham Townships [and] to the intersection with L. R. 62061. Begin again at the intersection of L. R. 62014; thence in a southeasterly direction in Union Township, via Mingo Creek and Henry's Bridge, to State Route 247 near Riverview, in Washington County, a distance of about [8.5] 5.1 miles.

[Route 62055. Beginning at State Route 181 at Kammerer; thence northerly to intersection of the Mingo Creek Road near the Sumney School, in Washington County, a distance of about 0.8 miles.]

Section 2. On and after the effective date of this amending act those portions of Routes 62032 and 62055 deleted by this amending act shall be maintained, constructed and reconstructed by Washington County.

Section 3. This act shall take effect December 15, 1974.
