## AN ACT

## **HB 53**

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for the time of the physical examination.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 643, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended to read:

Section 643. Physical Examinations.—All applicants for examination shall undergo a physical examination which shall be conducted under the supervision of a doctor of medicine appointed by the commission. No person shall be eligible [to take an examination] for appointment until said doctor certifies that the applicant is free from any bodily or mental defects, deformity or disease that might incapacitate him from the discharge of the duties of the position desired.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
