Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," providing further for hunting by minors.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (d) of section 316, act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), known as "The Game Law," amended October 6, 1972 (P.L.892, No.208), is amended to read:

Section 316. Certain Acts Declared Unlawful.—It is unlawful for any person:

\* \* \*

(d) To use firearms of any kind, or a bow and arrow, for the purpose of hunting any wild birds or wild animals unless, if between the ages of twelve and fourteen, accompanied by a parent *or a person serving in loco parentis* or guardian, or some other member of his family eighteen years of age, or older, or if between the ages of fourteen and sixteen years, unless accompanied by an adult at least eighteen years of age, unless such hunting is done on the premises whereon such person resides;
