#### AN ACT

# HB 1335

Providing for adoption of capital projects to be financed from current revenues of the General Fund, and making appropriations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Itemization and Authorization of Projects.—The 1975-1976 Capital Budget projects in the category of public improvement projects, to be financed from current revenues of the General Fund, are hereby itemized together with their respective estimated costs, as follows:

much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated for completion of the above itemized capital improvement projects:

(1) The sum of \$50,000 to the Department of Education.

(2) The sum of \$168,000 to the Department of Environmental Resources.

(3) The sum of \$132,000 to the Historical and Museum Commission.

(4) The sum of \$181,000 to the Department of Justice.

(5) The sum of \$162,000 to the Department of Public Welfare.

Section 3. Lapse of Funds.—Whatsoever of the amounts herein appropriated are unexpended or unencumbered as of June 30, 1976, shall lapse.

Section 4. Effective Date.—This act shall take effect July 1, 1975, or, if enacted subsequent to that date, immediately.
