## AN ACT

## HB 813

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," making an additional change to conform to existing law.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 410, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), and amended July 13, 1961 (P.L.596, No.294), is amended to read:

Section 410. Supervisors.—Except as is otherwise provided for the election of additional supervisors in townships having a population of **[ten] three** thousand or more, at each municipal election, the electors of each township shall elect one supervisor to serve for a term of six years from the first Monday of January next following his election.

Except as provided in section 514, no supervisor shall at the time hold any other elective or appointive township office or position other than township roadmaster or secretary-treasurer.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be retroactive to March 1, 1974.
