Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled "An act relating to counties of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," increasing the authorized amounts of the annual assessments for the necessary expenses of the association of county commissioners.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 445, act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as "The County Code," amended January 18, 1968 (1967 P.L.966, No.430), is amended to read:

Section 445. Annual Assessments for County Commissioners, Etc.—(a) In addition to the expenses hereinbefore authorized, the necessary expenses of the association of county commissioners, county solicitors and chief clerks shall be apportioned among the counties holding membership in the association in amounts provided for by the rules and regulations of the association but shall not total more than:

- (1) [six hundred dollars (\$600)] twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200) for any county of the third class;
- (2) [five hundred dollars (\$500)] one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for any county of the fourth class;
- (3) [four hundred dollars (\$400)] eight hundred dollars (\$800) for any county of the fifth class;
- (4) [three hundred dollars (\$300)] six hundred dollars (\$600) for any county of the sixth class;
- (5) [two hundred dollars (\$200)] four hundred dollars (\$400) for any county of the seventh class; or
- (6) [one hundred fifty dollars (\$150)] three hundred dollars (\$300) for any county of the eighth class per annum.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
