Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," increasing the authorized amount of the annual assessments for the necessary expenses of the association of county commissioners.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 437, act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code," amended June 30, 1969 (P.L.101, No.38), is amended to read:

Section 437. Annual Assessments for County Commissioners, Etc.—(a) In addition to the expenses hereinbefore authorized, the necessary expenses of the association of county commissioners, county solicitors and chief clerks shall be apportioned among the counties holding membership in the association in amounts provided for by the rules and regulations of the association, but shall not total more than [seven hundred dollars (\$700)] one thousand six hundred dollars (\$1,600) for counties of the second and second A class.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
