## AN ACT

## HB 996

Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing appropriations for observances and celebrations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners. The board shall have power—

\* \* \*

***LXIX. Appropriations for Observances and Celebrations.—To appropriate annually an amount not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750) for the observance of holidays, centennials or other anniversaries or for township celebrations or civic projects or programs.***

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
