Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," authorizing the purchase of certain insurance against errors and omissions.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Article XXI, act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the "Second Class County Code," is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

ARTICLE XXI Special Powers and Duties of the County

(x) Insurance Liability for Errors and Omissions

Section 2199.18. Insurance to Cover Errors, Etc.—The county commissioners may provide insurance on every county officer and employe for liability arising from errors and omissions in the performance of their duties in the course of their employment. Their liability for surcharge in accordance with law shall not be affected hereby.
