SB 650

Designating a highway in Fayette and Greene Counties as the Roy E. Furman Highway.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. State Highway Route 21 from Uniontown in Fayette County to the West Virginia State line in Greene County shall be officially designated and known as the Roy E. Furman Highway in honor of the former member of the House of Representatives, Speaker of the House, Lieutenant Governor, member of the Turnpike Commission, member of the original Pennsylvania Highway Commission, member of the original General State Authority, and presently a member of the State Transportation Commission.

Section 2. The Secretary of Transportation shall erect suitable markers in order to carry out the provisions of this act.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
