## AN ACT

**HB 258** 

Amending the act of August 12, 1971 (P.L.299, No.75), entitled "An act regulating snowmobiles, providing for registrations and fees, and providing penalties," further providing for operation of snowmobiles.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 4, act of August 12, 1971 (P.L.299, No.75), entitled "An act regulating snowmobiles, providing for registrations and fees, and providing penalties," is amended to read:

Section 4. Operation.—\* \* \*

(c) Except as otherwise provided in this act, it shall be unlawful to operate a snowmobile on any street or highway which is not designated and posted as a snowmobile road by the governmental agency having jurisdiction. A political subdivision of any county shall have the authority to designate any road or street within its jurisdiction as a snowmobile street or road and may, in its discretion, determine whether such street or road shall be closed to vehicular traffic or whether snowmobiles may share this designated street or road with vehicular traffic: Provided, That adequate notices are sufficiently and prominently displayed. In the case of State highways the authority for designation as snowmobile highways shall be vested in the Department of Transportation.
