Amending the act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), entitled "An act concerning townships of the first class; amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," providing for appropriations for building hospitals.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1502, act of June 24, 1931 (P.L.1206, No.331), known as "The First Class Township Code," reenacted and amended May 27, 1949 (P.L.1955, No.569), is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 1502. The corporate power of a township of the first class shall be vested in the board of township commissioners. The board shall have power—

\* \* \*

***LXX. Building Hospitals.—To appropriate not exceeding one dollar (\$1) per township resident per year toward the maintenance and/or support of any medical center or hospital building and further appropriate from such funds toward the purchase and/or erection of medical or hospital facilities. Where the total cost of such purchase or erection exceeds one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000), it will necessitate approval by the appropriate health planning agency. The number of residents shall be determined from the latest decennial Federal census.***

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
