Repealing the act of May 10, 1893 (P.L.37, No.33), entitled "An act to prevent deception and fraud by owners or agents who may have control of any stallion kept for service, by proclaiming or publishing fraudulent or false pedigrees or records, and to protect such owners or agents in the collection of fees for services of such stallions."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The act of May 10, 1893 (P.L.37, No.33), entitled "An act to prevent deception and fraud by owners or agents who may have control of any stallion kept for service, by proclaiming or publishing fraudulent or false pedigrees or records, and to protect such owners or agents in the collection of fees for services of such stallions," is repealed.

Section 2. After the effective date of this act no action shall be brought against an owner or an agent of an owner for any cause arising under the act repealed hereby.

Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
