SB 249

Amending the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.857, No.154), entitled "An act providing for the capital budget for the fiscal year 1976-1977," increasing the amount of funds for highway and public improvement projects.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2, act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.857, No.154), known as the "Capital Budget Act of 1976-1977 Fiscal Year," is amended to read:

Section 2. Overall Limitations on Debt to be Incurred for Capital Projects.—The maximum principal amount of additional debt to be incurred hereafter during the 1976-1977 fiscal year and thereafter until the enactment of the 1977-1978 capital budget specifying such maximum debt for the 1977-1978 fiscal year, for capital projects specifically itemized in a capital budget pursuant to section 7(a)(4) of Article VIII of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, and the fund to be charged with the repayment of such debt shall, with respect to each category of capital projects, be as follows:

Category	Amount	Fund
(1) Highway Projects	[\$200,000,000] \$240,000,000	Motor License Fund
(2) Public Improvement Projects: Department of General Services	[1,000,000] 145,000,000	General Fund or Special Fund as applicable
(3) Transportation Assistance Projects Total	30,000,000 [\$330,000,000] \$415,000,000	General Fund

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
