Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," increasing the allowable expense for attending the annual meeting of township supervisors.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 612, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567) and amended May 21, 1976 (P.L.146, No.70), is amended to read:

Section 612. Expenses and Mileage.—The expenses allowed the delegates attending the annual meeting may be in an amount not exceeding [fifty dollars] seventy-five dollars per day for each delegate for not more than four days including the time employed in traveling thereto and therefrom, together with [twelve cents per mile in] mileage going to and returning from such meeting.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
