SB 624

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," providing for the regulations of recreational facilities.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Clause (2) of section 1202, act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," is amended to read:

Section 1202. Specific Powers.—The powers of the borough shall be vested in the corporate authorities. Among the specific powers of the borough shall be the following, and in the exercise of any of such powers involving the enactment of any ordinance or the making of any regulation, restriction or prohibition, the borough may provide for the enforcement thereof and may prescribe penalties for the violation thereof or for the failure to conform thereto:

* * *

(2) Regulation of charges in the operation of its utilities, parking meters, parking lots, [or] *recreational facilities* or its other facilities and services to the public. In the operation of its utilities, parking meters, parking lots, *recreational facilities*, and other facilities and services, to make and regulate charges therefor for general borough purposes [in relief of taxes on real estate].

* * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
