Amending the act of December 9, 1969 (P.L.333, No.141), entitled "An act enabling certain minors' consent to donate blood," changing the age of consent for blood donations.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 1, act of December 9, 1969 (P.L.333, No.141), entitled "An act enabling certain minors' consent to donate blood," is amended to read:

Section 1. Any person of the age of [eighteen] seventeen years or over shall be eligible to donate blood in any voluntary and noncompensatory program without the necessity of obtaining parental permission or authorization.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
