Amending the act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), entitled "An act establishing certain township roads as State highways; authorizing their construction, maintenance, and improvement under certain conditions and restrictions; limiting the obligation of the Commonwealth in the construction of certain structures located on such highways; conferring certain powers upon the Department of Highways and local authorities, persons, associations and corporations for sharing the cost of the maintenance and construction of such highways; and making an appropriation to carry out the provisions of said act," amending a route in West Bradford Township, Chester County.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. As much of section 16 as relates to Route 15076, act of June 22, 1931 (P.L.594, No.203), referred to as the Township State Highway Law, is amended to read:

Section 16. The township roads to be taken over, under the provisions of this act, in the County of Chester, are those situate and described as follows:

* * *

Route 15076. Beginning at a point of road intersection about 1.25 miles northeast of Romansville in West Bradford Township; thence northeasterly through West Bradford Township, via the Shadyside School, on Shadyside Road, to a point of road intersection with Harmony Hill Road, thence by Harmony Hill Road, to a point on Route 137 near Station [260] 904, at about two miles south of the southern boundary line of Downingtown Borough, in Chester County, a distance of about [2.8] 2.6 miles.

* * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon certification by the Department of Transportation that West Bradford Township has satisfactorily completed the improvements on Harmony Hill Road specified in an agreement between said township and the department.
