Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled, as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for county commissioners to make contracts.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 2001(d) of the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is amended by adding a clause to read:

Section 2001. County Commissioners to Make Contracts.—The County Commissioners may make contracts for lawful purposes and for the purposes of carrying into execution the provisions of this section and the laws of the Commonwealth.

(d) The contracts or purchases made by the commissioners involving an expenditure of over four thousand dollars (\$4,000) which shall not require advertising or bidding as hereinbefore provided are as follows:

* * *

(6) Those involving tangible client services provided by nonprofit agencies. For the purposes of this clause, the term "tangible client services" shall mean congregate meals, home-delivered meals, transportation and chore services provided through area agencies on aging.

* * *

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
