Amending the act of August 22, 1953 (P.L.1344, No.383), entitled "An act relating to marriage; and amending, revising, consolidating and changing the law relating thereto," further providing for marriage license applications.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of the act of August 22, 1953 (P.L.1344, No.383), known as The Marriage Law, is amended to read:

Section 3. Application for License to Marry.—No license to marry shall be issued by any clerk of the orphans' court except upon written and verified application made by both of the parties intending to marry. Such application shall contain a statement of the full [Christian] given name and surname of the male and female applicant, race, occupation, birthplace, residence, and ages of the parties, whether the marriage contemplated is the first, second, or other marriage, and that neither of the contracting parties is afflicted with transmissible disease, together with the full [Christian] given name and surname, residence, race, occupation, and birthplace of their parents, including the maiden name of the mother, together with such other facts as may be necessary to determine whether any legal impediment to the proposed marriage exists.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
