HB 1477

Amending the act of July 1, 1978 (P.L.584, No.109), entitled "An act establishing an agency to create the linkage necessary for the planning of an economic development system for Pennsylvania, and making an appropriation," further providing for grants to area labor management committees.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 6.1(c) of the act of July 1, 1978 (P.L.584, No.109), known as the *Milrite Act*, amended July 9, 1986 (P.L.1207, No.104), is amended to read:

Section 6.1. Area labor management committees.

* * *

(c) The council shall designate the area labor management committees which are entitled to receive grants pursuant to subsection (a). Funds appropriated to the [**Department of Commerce**] *Milrite Council* for grants to area labor management committees shall be made to those committees, in amounts and under conditions specified by the council, and under the following conditions:

(1) The grant shall be matched with as much non-State funds as possible, within the overall goal of attempting to establish and maintain as many area labor management committees as possible.

(2) While the highest priority for these funds shall be for the establishment of new area labor management committees, the council shall make use of the money available to it for the grants to ensure the continued existence and expansion of existing area labor management committees, including the provisions of technical assistance and nonmatching grants.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
