Amending Title 54 (Names) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, adding the Pennsylvania State Police to the definition of "organization."

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The definition of "organization" in section 1301 of Title 54 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 1301. Definitions.

The following words and phrases when used in this chapter shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

"Organization." [Any] The Pennsylvania State Police or any association, lodge, order, fraternal society, beneficial association, or fraternal and beneficial society or association, historical, military or veterans' organization, labor union, foundation, federation, or any other society, organization or association, or any degree, branch, subordinate lodge or auxiliary thereof, whether incorporated or unincorporated, the principles and activities of which are not repugnant to the Constitution and laws of the United States or of this Commonwealth.

Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
