Designating a bridge over the Allegheny River in Allegheny County, as the Joseph F. Bonetto Memorial Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Name of bridge.

The bridge over the Allegheny River, known as the Hulton Bridge, which carries L.R.02236 between the Borough of Oakmont and the Township of Harmar in Allegheny County is hereby officially designated and shall be known as the Joseph F. Bonetto Memorial Bridge.

Section 2. Signs or markers.

The Department of Transportation shall erect appropriate signs or markers to evidence the name of the bridge.

Section 3. Effective date.

This act shall take effect immediately.
