Repealing in part a limitation on the complement of the Pennsylvania State Police.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 205(b) of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is repealed to the extent that it limits the aggregate number of Pennsylvania State Police members to less than 4,310 persons, provided that Pennsylvania State Police members assigned to duty with the Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission or as resident State troopers shall be excluded in determining such number.

Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
