Designating a bridge on that portion of S.R. 3100 over Interstate 83 in Springfield Township, York County, as the Rodney P. Miller Memorial Bridge.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Rodney P. Miller Memorial Bridge.

(a) Findings.—

(1) Rodney Paul Miller, Fire Chief of the Loganville Fire Company in Loganville, York County, died on April 27, 2013, in the line of duty.

(2) Mr. Miller began his service as a junior volunteer firefighter at 16 years of age, rising through the ranks to become 1st assistant fire chief and ultimately chief in 2001.

(3) Mr. Miller served his Commonwealth and community with courage and distinction.

(b) Designation.—The bridge located on S.R. 3100 over Interstate 83 in Springfield Township, York County, is hereby designated as the Rodney P. Miller Memorial Bridge.

(c) Signs.—The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

Section 2. Effective date.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
