## CHAPTER XV.

## An ACT for the relief of Peter Williams.

WHEREAS, it appears by the petition of Peter Williams, formerly a drummer in the third Pennfylvania regiment, that he has loft a certificate, number four hundred and feventy-one, for the fum of eighty-eight pounds one fhilling and nine pence, granted him for the depreciation of his pay, and on which one year's intereft hath been paid: And whereas, it alfo appears, by information from the comp-troller-general, that the faid certificate hath not been redeemed by this commonwealth: Therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and Houfe of Reprefentatives of the Commonrocalth of Pennfyluania, in General Afembly met, and it is The Governor hereby eracted by the authorily of the fame, That to draw his warrant in favour of Peter Williams for f. 88: I: 9 with interent. the Governor be, and he is hereby authorifed to draw his warrant upon the flate-treafurer, in favor of Peter Williams, for the fum of eighty-eight pounds one fhilling and nine pence, together with lawful intereft on the faid fum, from the firft day of July, one thoufand feven hundred and eighty-four, until the firft day of Auguft, one thoufand feven hundred and ninetytwo.
