CHAPTER XXVIII.

An ACT for the Relief of Alexander Patterson.

X THEREAS it appears that Alexander Patterson, of Easton, in Northampton county, in the revolutionary war, performed as a captain, very effential fervices to this Commonwealth: Therefore.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the same, That four hundred dollars be, and the fame An annuity is hereby granted to the aforesaid Alexander for life grant-Patterson; and also an annuity of one hundred terson. dollars, to be paid half yearly, during his life; the aforefaid fums, to be paid out of any unappropriated monies in the treasury of this Commonwealth, on warrants drawn by the Governor, as in other cases.
