### CHAPTER XXXVI.

An ACT for the relief of John Gilchrift.

WHEREAS it appears that John Gilchrift, of the borough of Harriburgh, while in the fervice of this state in the late revolutionary war, received a wound, by reason whereof he is rendered unable to procure a maintenance by manual labour: Therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That An annuity of the aforesaid John Gilchrist be, and he is hereby lars granted to allowed an annuity of fixty-four dollars, from John Gilchrist the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and three, and to continue during his life,
