CHAPTER LXI.

An ACT to raife by way of lottery a fum not exceeding ten thousand dollars, for the use and benefit of the trustees and members of the fourth Presbyterian church in the city of Philadelphia.

Section 1. DE it enacted by the Senate and Houfe of Reprefentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennfylvania, in General Assembly mer, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, That Alexander Moore, Ro-Commillionere bert Gordon, David Miller, Edward Hanna, to superintend the lottery. Archibald Little, Robert Erwin and Robert McCullough, be, and they are hereby appointed commillioners, to raife, by way of lottery, a fum of money not exceeding ten thousand The sum to be dollars, for the purposes of discharging the raifed. debts of the trustees, and members of the fourth Presbyterian church of the city of Philadelphia, and of enabling them to complete The purpose. the building of their house of worship.

Sec. 2.
