their legal representatives, the said parties indemnifying the commonwealth against the reproduction of the certificates (stated to have been lost) in such manner, and with such security as the Governor shall direct and approve.

## CHAPTER CXII.

An ACT to enable James Wullis to obtain a Title to a Lot of Land in the township of Charlestown, and county of Chester.

HEREAS it has been represented to the legislature, that James Wallis did purchase of Llewellin Davis a lot of land, containing about one acre and fixty-five perches, situate in the township of Charlestown, in the county of Chester, and hath actually paid the full consideration for the same, according to the terms of an agreement made in the life-time of the said Llewellin Davis, who is since dead, by reason whereof he is deprived of the means of obtaining a title thereto; and as no written contract was made respecting the premises, he therefore

therefore prays the legislature to authorise the administrator and administratrix of the said Llewellin Davis to execute a deed to him the faid James Wallis, his heirs and affigns: And whereas the faid administrator and administratrix, by their certificate annexed to faid petition, mutually concur in the justice and propriety of the measure: Therefore,

Section 1. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That The representthe administrator and administratrix of the said atives of Lle-Llewellin Davis, deceased, be and they are empowered to hereby authorifed, on behalf of the faid de convey, in fee ceased, to convey to the said James Wallis, his simple, to J. heirs and affigns, the lot of land aforefaid, tain lot of agreeably to the buts, boundaries and terms ground in Chestercounty. of the agreement aforesaid: Provided always, That nothing herein contained shall be deemed or construed to bar or defeat any other person or persons, bodies politic or corporate, of any right, title, interest, claim or demand which they may have in or to the faid lot or piece of land or any part thereof.
