# CHAPTER X.

An ACT authorifing the Governor to employ Counfel to attend to the Interests of this State, in certain Suits pending in the Supreme Court of the United States.

Section 1. B E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwcalth of Pennfylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the fame, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorifed to employ one or more able counfel,

The Governor authorifed to counfel, to attend to the interests of this Com- employ counmonwealth, in and to certain lands lying north fel on behalf of and weft of the rivers Obio and Allachany and the State, &c. and west of the rivers Ohio and Alleghany, and Conewango creek, fo far as the fame are involved in certain fuits or points of law, now pending in the Supreme Court of the United States; and to draw his warrant or warrants in favor of fuch counfel, for fuch fum or fums as he may think proper, not exceeding in the whole fix hundred dollars; to be paid out of any unappropriated monies in the treasury of this Commonwealth: Provided always, That the appearance and attendance of counfel as aforefaid, fhall not be conftrued to acknowledge any power or jurisdiction of faid court in the plea aforefaid, other than faid court has heretofore conftitutionally poffeffed and exercifed.
