CHAPTER XIII.

An ACT to raise, by Way of Lottery, a Sum not exceeding Three Thousand Dollars, for the Use and Benefit of the Union Academy at Doyl-town, in the County of Bucks.

Section 1. DE it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in Geneaal Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the autho-Commissioners rity of the same, That Andrew Dunlap, Christian Clamens, John Hough, Thomas Stewart, Hugh Meredith, Nathaniel Shewell and Josiah Y. Shaw, be, and they are hereby appointed Commissioners to raife, by way of lottery, a fum of money not exceeding three thousand dollars, for the purposes of discharging the debts of the Trustees of the Union Academy at Doyl-town, in the

mamed; fum to be raised, and use to which it is to be applied.
