CHAPTER XIV.

A SUPPLEMENT to an Act, entitled, an Act conferring certain Powers on the Commissioners of Berks County, and for other Purposes.

WHEREAS by an act of the Legislature, passed the second day of April, one thousand eight hundred and four, a power was vested in the commissioners of Berks county, to collect, recover and receive the arrearages of taxes due from the county of Berks to this Commonwealth. And whereas doubts have arisen, whether the said law authorized the commissioners aforesaid, to recover and receive the arrears of taxes already collected and in the hands of the former county treasurer, or the monies due to the State by the bail of the former county treasurer, and also the taxes in the hands of the present

present county treasurer : Therefore to obviate those doubts,

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of Berks county be, and they are hereby authorized to recover and receive the arrears of taxes due to this Commonwealth from said county of Berks, already collected and in the hands of the former county treasurer, or due to the Commonwealth from the bail of the former county treasurer; and also the taxes due to the Commonwealth, which have been collected, and are in the hands of the present county treasurer; and appropriate the same to the purpose mentioned in the act, to which this is a supplement.
