CHAPTER XVI.

An ACT to erect Buffaloe Township, in the County of Cumberland, into a separate Election-District.

Section 1. B E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the autho-Buffaloctown-rity of the same, That from and after the passing ship, in Cumberland country, creded in berland country, shall be a separate election-to an election-district, and the electors thereof shall hold their general elections at the house now occupied by William Thomson, in Buffaloe township aforesaid; any law to the contrary notwithstanding.
