

CHAPTER XXXI.

An ACT empowering the Commissioners of Beaver and Butler Counties to collect certain Arrearages of County Taxes.

Section 1. **B**E it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the commissioners of the counties of Beaver and Butler respectively, and their successors in office, shall be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to recover and collect the arrearages of taxes due on unfeated lands in said counties, which taxes remained unpaid at the time of their organization, and, if necessary, to proceed and sell the said lands, or any part of them respectively, to discharge the taxes due as aforesaid; subject to the rules, regulations and restrictions provided by an act of Assembly, passed April the third, one thousand eight hundred and four, entitled, "An act directing the mode of selling unfeated lands for taxes;" which sales, thus made and conducted, and the titles made by virtue of the same, shall be valid in law to all intents and purposes.
