CHAPTER XXXI.

An ACT empowering the Commissioners of Beaver and Butler Counties to collect certain Arrearages of County Taxes.

DE it enacted by the Senate and Section 1. D House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is bereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the commissioners of the fioners of Bea- counties of Beaver and Butler respectively, and ver and Butler their fuccessors in office, shall be, and they are thorifed to re-hereby authorifed and empowered to recover and collect the arrearages of taxes due on unfeated lands in faid counties, which taxes remained unpaid at the time of their organization, and, if necessary, to proceed and fell the said lands, or any part of them respectively, to discharge the taxes due as aforefaid; subject to the rules, regulations and restrictions provided by an act of Assembly, passed April the third, one thousand eight hundred and four, entitled, "An act directing the mode of felling unfeated lands for taxes;" which fales, thus made and conducted, and the titles made by virtue of the fame, shall be valid in law to all intents and purposes.
